

Suggestions for Developing Elearning Courses

To maximize your learners really absorbing the materials:

- 1. Write out what you want the learner to be able to know and do by the end of the whole course, and by the end of each lesson.
- 2. Outline your content and learning activities for each lesson. Make sure that the content and learning activities will lead your learner to what you want them to know and be able to do by the end of each lesson and by the end of the whole course.
- 3. Put very little content on each page. Spread it out, with no more than two or three sentences or five bullets per page.
- 4. Put a title at the top of each page to help your learners orient to where they are.
- 5. Put audios on as many pages as possible.
- 6. Put meaningful photos that relate to your topic on a number of the pages, for those learners who learn best through images.
- 7. Reduce all photos to 72 dpi, using one of the programs listed on the second page.
- 8. Place the photos in different orientations, from one page to another to keep learner attention (ex. Page 1 photo is horizontal left, and Page 2 photo is horizontal right).
- Every few pages (3-5), insert an interactive exercise related to the last few pages of content. The interactive exercise could be on a Skills Drills, Interactive Workbook, Notes, Self-assessment, Assessment. Goals, Action Items or Progress Report Template.
- 10. Include summaries of key points.
- 11. To keep learners engaged, tell learners that they will need to report on some aspect of the course during their performance assessment (ex. Inserted at the end of the bullying course: You will be asked to discuss two bullying episodes you witnessed, during your performance assessment. Be prepared to label their type and discuss how they were handled. Would you have handled them the same or differently?).
- 12. Use PeakSkills' free animations to spice up your courses at appropriate points.
